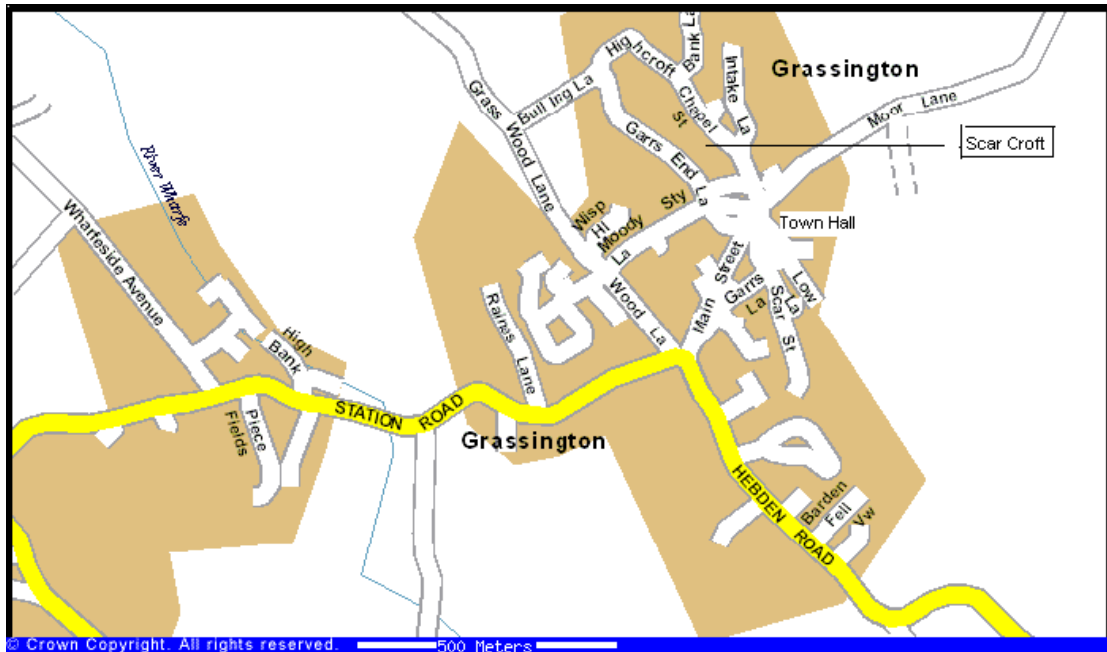

Scar Croft

Our family home is in a quiet location in the busy village of Grassington, but is just two minutes walk from the village square. There are two rooms available one twin bedded and one double; both rooms are ensuite, and have colour television and tea/coffee making facilities etc. Our rates are £25 per person per night based on two sharing (minimum two night stay), £30 per person is charged for single occupancy of a room or stays of one night. A Full English breakfast is served from 7.30am.

Time of arrival is by prior arrangement, and we ask that rooms are vacated by 10.00am on the day of departure. There is ample private car parking.

Grassington, a picturesque Wharfedale village, has many good restaurants and pubs serving a variety of food. There are a number of shops, including a post office and these along with the public houses and restaurants are all just a few minutes walk from Scar Croft.

The Dales is famous for miles of beautiful countryside along with its multitude of walks including the Dalesway which runs along Chapel Street.

Further afield is Skipton (10 miles), with its castle and bustling market (Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday). Approximately 26 miles away is Harrogate, a historic spa town where the famous "Betty's Tea-rooms" are situated, and Ripon (34 miles) with its delightful cathedral and adventure theme park, plus factory outlet, Lightwater Valley.

The area also boasts many National Trust Properties and sites of historical interest, such as Benningborough Hall, Nr York, Fountains Abbey, Nr Ripon and Ripley Castle, Nr Harrogate.

How to Find Us

Travel along the A59 on the outskirts of Skipton, take the B6265 to Grassington. Turn left into Main Street, keep the square on your right, continue up Main Street until you reach the Town Hall on your right, turn left into Chapel Street, just past the Methodist Chapel on your right the road splits, keep to the left, just after, there are two garages on the right, facing is the driveway to Scar Croft. After parking walk through the gateway and on your left are steps leading down to the front door.
